

**SHS PTO Minutes**  
**May 14, 2018**

**Old Business/Updates from last meeting:**

- HOSA requested funds for a conference. We are asking them include in their submission a specific amount. If they need up to \$250 we will approve off-line in exchange for 5 concession shifts.
- Tamsen Profit requested funds for a bulk buy of in-classroom calculators for students tests (in lieu of them having to buy a second calculator). This request includes \$560 for 8 teachers who will have 10 calculators per classroom with a positive impact to 80 kids; springs for \$330 for the physics classes impacting 60 kids during the "springs" unit. Motion approved.
- Motion approved to give the SHS lacrosse team \$250 towards hosting a team dinner for the visiting Bend team in exchange for 5 concession stand shifts. The reason this was approved is the lacrosse team is primarily club funded (player and family). This was a gesture of good sportsmanship and reciprocation for a dinner that the Bend team provided during an away game.
- During the month of April, the board approved a \$150 funds request from Mr. Galbraith for sheets of wood for DNA models for science classes.
